





The 2-Day training is considered an introduction to Orton-Gillingham or a refresher course.

The 3-Day training is necessary for those who are looking to instruct immediately and those working in a classroom or an RTI setting.

4-Day Training is considered an advanced beginner level (as this is the highest level of introductory training). Teachers/instructors leave this course with a 36-hour certificate and a “Classroom Orton-Gillingham Instructor” Credential that is nationally recognized.



1. Are you members of any Orton-Gillingham Company?

Yes, we are members of the International Dyslexia Association. Our member ID is 173853.

2. Are you vendors?

3. Do you accept purchase orders?

Yes, we do. We accept them via email and regular mail.

4. What if I only want to register (1-5 people)

That's no problem. We are happy to help no matter the number of registrants.

5. What credentials do I receive after training?

Credentials are dependent upon the training you have received. We offer initial Orton-Gillingham training which supplies teachers with the "Classroom Instructor Credentials" and allows teachers to begin using the Orton-Gillingham method immediately. Those seeking certification, receive "Certified Orton-Gillingham Instructor Credential" or the "Dyslexia Instructor Credential". Certification credentials require more education and practicum.

6. What credentials do I receive after training and completing the certification process?

You receive the Certified Orton-Gillingham Classroom Instructor Credential.

7. Can I receive college credits?

You may be able to. You will have to apply for ACE credit and use those credits as transfer credits to your school. This is not something we handle, and you would be responsible for seeking college credits independently.

8. Can I receive continuing education credits/CTLE credits?

Many have been successful in receiving continuing education credits. We provide you with a certificate of completion or your certification credential and you can use this as evidence of your training for continuing education credits. Acceptance may be at the discretion of your school or school district.

9. What level of on-site training is the online course equivalent to?

Our online course is equivalent to the 4-Day onsite training for our highest level of introductory training. It is 36 hours in length, but the time it will take you to complete will be dependent on several factors. We provide a full year of access to the course, so there's enough time to complete it.

9. What level of on-site training is the online course equivalent to?

11. Can you explain how the online course works?

Sure. The online course is fairly easy to navigate. The course requires high-speed internet access and access to an Android, iPhone, Computer or Tablet. There is nothing to download as the course is available directly through our course website.

Here's the process step by step

1. Provide your email address, name, and school.
2. We set-up your account and you are sent a welcome email with detailed instructions on how to log in and your username and password. (If you have been set-up by your school/district, your administration will be sent a master list of usernames, passwords, and URLs)
3. You will log in using the website link, username and password provided.

4. The course includes a series of chapters and chapter modules that must be completed in succession of each other. The course is also equipped with video, support, and tests.

5. You can download and use all the materials provided within the downloads section of your course.

We provide a full year of access to the course, so there's enough time to complete the course.

12. When do I receive my certificate?

If you have taken the course online, your certificate is available immediately and will be accessible directly through your course and on www.accredible.com . If you received your instruction onsite, certificates of completion (of all levels) generally take 14 days to be made available online or to be emailed. There are some times of the year when it may take 4-5 weeks to receive your certificate(s)- in these instances, you will be alerted in advance.

13. Are curriculums necessary to teach Orton-Gillingham?

Orton- Gillingham is one of the most customizable reading instruction/intervention programs in existence, and this is also why it is so appealing to all different levels of teachers. It is helpful to newer teachers to start with a curriculum and provides a guide of where to go next. We provide free materials so that you can begin immediately and if not, we provide curriculums based on grade at an additional cost.

14. Do you offer dyslexia training/certification?

We offer dyslexia practitioner training and certification, please see the description above for what we cover in this course.

15. What's the process of registering for Orton-Gillingham online?

1. As a school or district? If you are registering as a school/school district who wants on-site training we would need to know where you're located, how many people you want to have trained, what training you are interested in and your desired dates- once we have this information you are invoiced and Purchase Order or Check is made, and we begin work. Online training is the same process, except the cost is less and we do not require a begin date, although it can be helpful.

2. As an individual? Registering as an individual is super simple, you can register yourself online or simply have us invoice your school for payment.

16. Do you need any special credentials to start training or to become certified in Orton-Gillingham?

While there are no special credentials for training, if you are looking to become certified, a minimum of a bachelor's degree is required.

18. Can we complete a live-online training? What are the requirements?

Yes. We consider this the same as an onsite training but more convenient. Many schools choose this option over “school break” periods. All participants are required to have high-speed internet access and access to a computer or tablet during the duration of the time. The instructor provides direct instruction online to your school group- live instruction means teachers can ask and have their questions answered in real-time. We cover topics provided in a syllabus type form and teachers are expected to be present during the live class. The alternative to this is cohort training which is similar in the fact that all participants do all work at the same time and must be present together but it does not have a live instructor.

19. Can my group begin at the same time? Do you offer cohort training?

Yes. Please see the previous question.

20. How quickly can we start after online Orton-Gillingham registration?

Typically, your teachers can begin in less than a week. You would need to provide a signed, completed, approved or certified purchase order, or provide payment before full access to the course is granted. Once all of the payment details have been completed, we provide each participant with a username and password. Each individual is emailed the URL and a welcome email to the course. Once that happens and the start date is added to the course. On that date, participants can begin taking the course. They will have access to the course for 1 year from the start date provided.

21. Can you explain the certification process for Orton-Gillingham certification?

Orton-Gillingham certificate requires that you first complete an Orton-Gillingham training course that provides at least 30 hours of training (ours is 36). You must also possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree from an accredited university.

1. 36 Hour Course completion (Online or 4-Day onsite Training)
2. Complete application for certification and practicum
3. 60 hours of supervised practicum over 6-9 months
4. 6 (60-minute sessions) Live or Recorded full lessons in a group of 2 or more
5. 4 Separate Tests provided Online or In-Person

Generally, the process of certification takes roughly 7-9 months to complete. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and are available online. After completion, and acceptance of all tests, practicum, lesson plans, and other necessary submissions, participants are considered "Orton-Gillingham Classroom Instructor" Certified and certification is valid for 5 years.
